Introduction

This document provides the information necessary to an Inbox and Calendar component for Exchange OWA.

Objectives

- Create Exchange OWA Inbox component to display a user's Exchange Inbox.
- Create Exchange OWA Calendar component to display a user's Exchange Calendar.

Requirements

- webNetwork 4.0e installed
- Working Exchange OWA Web Application created in the webNetwork System. Review Microsoft OWA document for details.

Steps

1. Login to the webNetwork as a webNetwork administrator
2. Start webAdmin
3. Browse and locate the Stoneware container (organizational unit)
4. Create a webDesktop Component for the Exchange OWA Inbox
 - a. Select the CREATE a NEW OBJECT panel from the left frame
 - b. Select webDesktop Component from the list of objects
 - c. Select the NEXT button
 - d. Enter an object name for the inbox (i.e. - Exchange Inbox)
 - e. Select the CLOSE button

5. Run the Component WIZARD by selecting the WIZARD button
6. Select the LINK TO A WEB PAGE radio button
7. Select the NEXT button
8. Enter the component PROPERTIES
 - a. Title – **Inbox**
 - b. Description – **Exchange Inbox**
 - c. Category – **Mail**
 - d. Size – **Large**
 - e. Height - **400**
9. Select the NEXT button
10. Enter the URL to the Exchange Inbox JSP
 - a. [/apps/exchange/exchangeInbox.jsp?webAppObject=\[DN of the Exchange web application\]](#)

* The DN of the Exchange Web Application should be in the following format:

cn=Exchange,ou=stoneware,o=ABC (eDirectory and LocalTree)

cn=Exchange,ou=stoneware,dc=abc,dc=com (AD and OpenLDAP)

11. Check the SCROLLBOX box
12. Select NEXT to save
13. Assign the component to the webNetwork users
 - a. Select the ADD button
 - b. Browse and select the users that should have access
 - c. Select the OK button when complete
14. Select the DONE button to complete the wizard
15. Test the new component
 - a. Login as a user that has been granted access to the new component and has the ability to personalize their webDesktop.
 - b. Select the PERSONALIZE option and choose the new Exchange Inbox component.
 - c. Update the user's webDesktop page.
 - d. Verify that the component displayed the inbox properly.
